This tantalizing wine starts with fresh berry aromatics on the nose, followed by red berries and strawberry flavours on the palate. With its lingering crisp, dry finish this wine is synonymous with warm summer days and leisurely relaxation.

Now happily retired, she continues to bring beauty to the farm - by arranging the flowers in the manor house and cellar. This lively and fruity yet dry rosé celebrates a tenacious woman, overflowing with personality, who embodies the honesty and passion of Muratie and its people.

in the vineyard : The vines yielded approximately 6 tonnes per hectare.

about the harvest: Grapes were carefully hand-picked in the early morning.

in the cellar : This unique rosé is made from Grenache, Mourvedre and Shiraz grapes which are gently crushed and destalked. The juice has been left on the skins for only 5 hours allowing the delicate rose petal colour extraction. Cold fermentation facilitates a slow and steady fermentation which results in the production of a fruity, yet dry rosé.
