Medium bodied wine with plum and red berry flavours. Wine has well integrated and soft tannins. Hints of spice.

Recommended as a good partner to roasts and venison.

ageing : This wine can be enjoyed now, but will continue to improve for several years.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested separately at 24° B.

in the cellar : After the addition of selected yeasts the juice, together with the skins, were allowed to ferment at controlled temperatures of 25°C - 28°C. Regular pump overs ensured good colour and tannin extraction.

Merlot and Shiraz aged for 12 months in 2nd, 3rd and 4th fill French Oak barrels.
