about the harvest:

The grapes were hand-picked at 40° - 44° Balling in April.

in the cellar :

The juice was fermented at 13° to 14°C over 18 days. One third portion of the wine has been aged in a 500L new French oak barrel for 6 months. No malolactic fermentation was allowed.
