

Bellevue 1953 Pinotage 2017

Certified Heritage Vineyards wine made from 64-year old vines.

This wine shows maraschino cherry and plum flavours on the nose, complimented by a silky tannin structure and a lingering finish.

In good cellaring conditions, this wine has an ageing potential of 10 years plus.

about the harvest: Grapes harvested on February 25th at 25.3°B. Fermented at 26 - 28°C for about 4 days. Pumped over daily during alcoholic fermentation. Malolactic fermentation took place in barrels. The wine matured in new and 2nd fill French oak barrels for 18months.
