

## Windmeul Cabernet Sauvignon 2000

The South African Wine Trophy Show 2002 - Bronze

The wine has intense berry, plum, mint and wood aromas. It has complexity, a strong tannin structure and a long after taste.

**variety :** Cabernet Sauvignon | Cabernet Sauvignon

**wine of origin :** Coastal

**analysis :** alc : 14.0 % vol   rs : 2.7 g/l   pH : 3.5   ta : 5.8 g/l   va : 0.5 g/l

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**ageing :** 3-5 years

**in the vineyard :** Originating from the Paardeberg area the vineyards are Dry land and Bushvine vineyards. The vines are all above 15 years old and deliver a low yield. All these aspects produce grapes that have a very intense structure.

**in the cellar :** Ageing took place in French oak vats for 12 months. This gives more intensity adds a completeness to the wine. The wine will reach its peak in 3-5 years but it is already palatable.
