in the cellar : Grapes are soft crushed and the must fermented for 1525 days in French oak barrels (about 20% new). Malolactic fermentation occurs naturally during the 12 months the wine spends year of maturing on the lees, with the wine and lees regularly stirred for mouthfeel and complexity.
