The town of Wellington was established in 1840 and the name changed in honour of the 1st Duke of Wellington, renowned soldier and conqueror of Napoleon at the Battle of Waterloo. The Duke is a dynamic figure. The range collectively is known as DUKE which includes remarkably, well-balanced wines. Innovative and premium, the range includes one of only a handful of White Pinotage wines produced in the world, along with a Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz and Pinotage. To make something grand affordable, the DUKE range is a great quality wine at an accessible price point.

**about the harvest**: Special selection blocks were picked to ensure only the best grapes are used to produce Duke No5.

**in the cellar** : Special selection blocks were picked to ensure only the best grapes are used to produce Duke No5. The White Pinotage, a red grape varietal, treated as a white grape in the cellar. Hand pressing took place, slightly earlier than usual, with juice and skins separated early on, ensuring a crisp white colour.
