Warm and inviting nutty aromas are nuanced with wood, smoke and spice. A palate of ripe red berry fruit complemented by smooth structured tannins.

Game and roast vegetables brings out the spicyness in the wine and can also be enjoyed with hard cheeses and dark chocolate.

about the harvest: The grapes were picked at optimum maturity.

in the cellar : A selection of different pre-selected vineyards. The grapes were fermented dry on the skin at 26 degrees Celsius. Thereafter the free run portion was aged in oak barrels for 12-14 months.
