in the vineyard : The grapes for this wine comes from selected vineyards in Stellenbosch and Paarl.

Owing to the nature of bush vines, careful canopy management was exercised so that no bunches were exposed to excessive sunlight and an even ripening of the grapes.

about the harvest : The grapes were handpicked early in the morning. The average yield of these wonderful old vineyard was 6t/ha.
