**about the harvest:** Grapes were harvested at 24.5°B, destalked and transferred into closed fermenters where a portion of the juice was withdrawn to achieve better concentration.

**in the cellar :** Grapes were destalked and transferred into closed fermenters where a portion of the juice was withdrawn to achieve concentration. The remaining juice together with the grape skins were allowed to ferment at controlled temperatures of 25°C- 28°C.
