

Tokara Sauvignon Blanc 2021

The wine has a vibrant light straw colour with a brilliant pale green edge that catches the light. There is an appealing mix of fresh Granny Smith apple, delicate black currant leaf and lime blossom perfume on the nose. The wine enters the palate with concentrated flavours which follow through from the nose. The finish is refreshing and crisp with a slight oyster shell salinity that makes it quite moreish.

This wine is best enjoyed cold on a hot summer's day. Either on its own or it can be served with grilled chicken, fish, prawns or fresh oysters.
