in the cellar : A variety of Backsberg's premium red cultivars are blended together to create a soft, easy-drinking red wine. This wine incorporates portions of exceptional wines of various winemaking styles with high-quality oak-aged components building a beautiful backbone. An approachable blend for everyday enjoyment.
