

Bosman Family Vineyards Erfenis 2017

Deep, concentrated aromas of blackberry and red fruit. The oak lends integrated spicy notes. The flavours develop well in the glass or by decanting. Complex secondary flavours accented by lovely spicy notes from maturation in oak.

As a blend it is a wonderful wine to pair with a whole range of dishes from roasted duck to spicy meat dishes. A celebratory wine for special occasions.

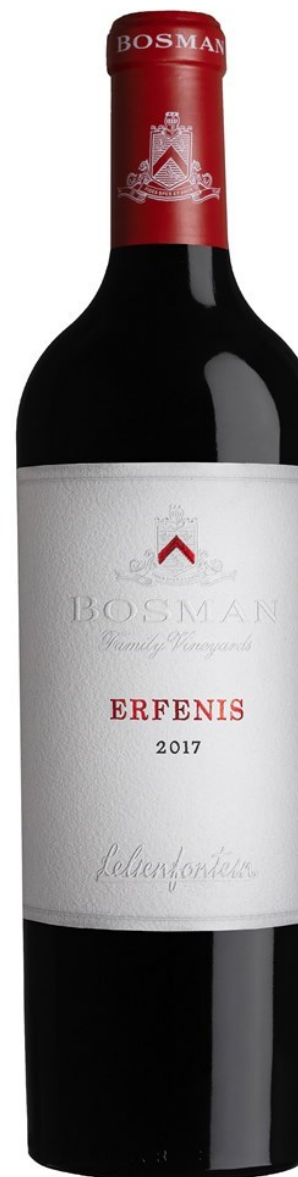
The word 'Erfenis' means both heritage and legacy in English. Understanding our heritage informs our present and allows us to create a sustainable legacy.

This wine is a blend of Cinsaut, Cabernet Sauvignon and Nero d'Avola. The blend reflects our heritage of producing quality, Cinsaut in the Bovelei, our conviction that every good red blend needs Cabernet, and our own unique addition is Nero.

"We picked the top sites on our farm, and vinified the grapes with a premium goal," explains winemaker Corlea Fourie. "And we chose these varietals because the Cabernet contributes the concentrated heart of the wine, the Nero gives spice and the Cinsaut adds the delicate nuance that intrigues.
