Deliciously refreshing aromas of gooseberry, sweet melon and kiwi with hints of citrus.
A well-balanced wine with delicate layers of stone fruit and citrus undertones. The wine ends in a fresh finish with a note of lime.

A great match with pork, Chinese food, mild curries, liver pâté and baked puddings.

Nederburg's 56HUNDRED range of refreshing, fruity and smooth-drinking wines takes its name from the fifty-six hundred guilders that Philippus Wolvaart used in 1791 to start the farm he was to call Nederburg. He had the vision to recognise the wine-growing potential of this land and the optimism and drive to clear an untamed property and establish a flourishing farm that continues to thrive today, more than two centuries later.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand and machine at 21° to 22°
Balling during February.

in the cellar : The fruit was crushed and a short period of skin contact was allowed for added aromatic expression. The clarified juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at 15° to 16°C prior to blending.
