

## Painted Wolf Peloton Blanc 2019

This is a fresh and vibrant wine with inviting citrus and pineapple aromas, supported by juicy passion fruit and hints of honey and cream on the palate. Crisp acidity and a long, dry finish.

**in the vineyard** : The grapes for this wine were sourced from Kasteelsig in the Swartland, Leeuwenkuil in Agter Paarl and vineyards in the Voor Paardeberg.

**in the cellar** : The grapes were hand-picked and whole-bunch pressed before being barrel-fermented. Both wild and commercial yeast strains were used. Southern Rhône white blends served as inspiration for this wine
