

## Nederburg 56Hundred Pinotage 2021

Aromas of mulberry, ripe plums and sweet berries, with gentle oak spice. Juicy berries, soft tannins and a lingering aftertaste on this medium-bodied wine.

Delicious with pasta, pizza, roast leg of lamb, bobotie and even chocolate.

Nederburg's 56HUNDRED range of refreshing, fruity and smooth-drinking wines takes its name from the fifty-six hundred guilders that Philippus Wolvaart used in 1791 to start the farm he was to call Nederburg. He had the vision to recognise the wine-growing potential of this land and the optimism and drive to clear an untamed property and establish a flourishing farm that continues to thrive today, more than two centuries later.

**in the cellar :** The grapes were harvested by hand and machine at 23° to 24° Balling from the end of January to mid-February. They were crushed and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks at 25°C to 28°C for seven days. After malolactic fermentation the wine was matured in contact with French and American oak for seven months.
