ageing : Those who can resist the temptation will be rewarded well with cellaring. Can be aged for 10 - 15 years.

First made in 2000, the Steytler Vision is our Cape Blend. Our endemic Pinotage creates a uniquely South African feel while Cabernet Sauvignon exudes power, length and structure. Gentle Merlot fruit binds it all together. The aptly named Steytler Vision is the realization of Danie Snr's innovation and craftsmanship.

in the vineyard : From vines planted between 1995 and 2002, these vines are all unirrigated and planted in low potential soils. Soil types are predominantly Clovelly and Tukululu.

in the cellar :

These individual varieties are aged and vinified separately before blending and bottling. The grapes are individually inoculated with a biodynamic yeast culture, and fermented on skins until dry. After malo-lactic conversion, the wine is transferred to barrels for ageing. After 20 months in barrel, the blend is carefully selected and bottled under inert conditions
