in the cellar : Grapes are harvested and destemmed before fermentation occurs. Regular pump-overs ensure good colour extraction and a gentle pressing results in tannin expression that is fine and subtle. A portion of the wine is matured in new French oak for 6 months to create a complex wine with supple tannins.
