in the vineyard : Strategically selected sites which get the warm sunny days and cooling effect of the Atlantic Ocean. Deep soils from decomposed granite, clay rich, good drainage

Vineyard type : Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest: Yield : 6 t/ha

Balling at Harvest : 24-25°B

in the cellar : Destalk and crush, 5-10 days fermentation at 24-26°C

Maturation: 8 months aged on French and American oak staves
