

## Arniston Bay Pinotage Cinsaut 2002

**Not available in South Africa**

This is a medium-bodied wine with a deep red colour and prominent cherry and black current flavours. This Pinotage Cinsaut has a soft middle palate with lingering fruity taste and a long finish.

Serve this wine with pasta with tomato-based sauces. This wine is suitable for vegetarians but not for vegans.
