This lively and fruity yet dry rosé celebrates a tenacious woman, overflowing with personality, who embodies the honesty and passion of Muratie and its people.

in the vineyard : This wine is made from meticulously selected grapes from different sites and slopes. The grapes were hand harvested by the Muratie team. We ensure optimal ripeness and quality prior to harvesting.

about the harvest: Grapes were hand harvested.

in the cellar : The grapes were sorted, crushed, destalked and transferred to the press. The juice was left on the skins for 2 hours allowing the delicate onion skin colour. Cold fermentation facilitates a slow and steady fermentation which results in the production of a fruity, yet dry rosé.
