Darling Cellars Reserve is a wine range of straight varietals where the focus is on fruit-driven, varietal true, value-for-money wines. The grapes were harvested from dryland farmed vineyards in Darling, where the vines are not trellised and planted as bush vines.

in the vineyard :

Terroir: Deep, decomposed granite soils on the slopes of the Darling Hills, with a cooling effect in the warm afternoons from the Atlantic Ocean in close proximity.
Vineyard type: Bush Vine with no irrigation

about the harvest:

Yield: 9t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 23°B

in the cellar :

Destalk and crush, 15 days fermentation

Maturation: Kept on light lees for 3 months for fuller mouth feel and complexity.



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
