This wine signifies something truly special to me as a winemaker and is part of my journey in life and wine in South Africa, hence the name, Camino Africana, "The African Way".

in the vineyard : Grapes were left to dry or develop noble rot every year on the vines that looked best suited to the required ripening.

about the harvest: Hand harvested, crushed and left to soak on skins for 24 hours. Pressed in a basket press. Fermented in old French oak and blended over 5 years in a solera styled system before racking, fining and filtration.
