This very elegant Rosé overwhelms the nose with aromas of freshly picked strawberries, rose petal and cherry flavours. It follows through on the palate with delicious ripe raspberries with a delicate finish.

Serve with all light summertime meals.

ageing : Should last half an hour with the cap off and reach for the next bottle!

in the vineyard : Region: Western Cape
Soil: Sandy/Decomposed Granite
Age of vines: 9 - 11 years
Altitude: 100m
Aspect: East-West Facing

about the harvest: The fruit is hand harvested as if to produce a white wine with high natural acidity, hence no added acid in the cellar.
Yield: 9 - 10 tons per hectare

in the cellar : Crushed and pressed, leaving the skins soaking for an hour or two. This infuses the delicate copper salmon colour unique for Grenache and a cold fermentation in stainless tanks ensures an elegant wine.
