These vineyards, situated near the Atlantic Ocean, benefit from an optimal climate and are planted in various soils that are perfect for cultivating high-quality grapes.

Terroir: Varying soils, from Koffieklip and Hutton to deep Granite.

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, dry land farmed

Yield: 6-10 t/ha

in the cellar : Vinification: Crush and destalk, 14 days fermentation



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
