in the cellar : This long lees contact, leading to autolysis of the yeast cells, enriches the wine beneficially resulting in the sought-after complexity. During the second fermentation in the bottle, the wine becomes very reductive and loaded with negative ions, a phenomenon which has a positive and uplifting effect on human beings.
