

Perdeberg Lighthearted Lower in Alcohol Cinsault Rose 2024

Colour: Salmon Pink

Bouquet: Fresh with a fruit-driven nose.

Taste: A light palate with bright, crisp red fruit and silky flavours of rose petals, with hints of strawberries on the finish

This wine pairs excellent with summer favourites like a summer berry salad with grilled chicken or greek yogurt panna cotta with strawberry sauce.

Sometimes the simplest experiences can spark the most joy: dewdrops glittering in the rising sun, the honey-sweet scent of wildflowers, a butterfly in flight. It's the beauty in the everyday that touches the heart and makes the spirit light. Light on the body, too, is this vibrant Rosé. Brimming with rose petal and red fruit notes, it is low in alcohol yet full in flavour.

about the harvest: Vintage: The 2024 harvest began two weeks earlier than the previous year due to unforeseen winds in late November and early December, resulting in a reduced yield. Despite this, elevated temperatures in early February necessitated an early grape harvest, with the anticipated quality remaining exceptional.

Harvested from a 29-year-old bush vine vineyard in the Paarl region, the grapes were picked at 23° Balling to ensure the fresh style of the wine.

in the cellar : Method: Under dryland conditions, Cinsault produces small berries with good flavour concentration. 30% of the wine was de-alcoholised mid-fermentation to achieve a low alcohol level. No lees contact took place after fermentation.
