

Hartenberg Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz 2022

Deep ruby in colour with tinges of purple, exuding opulent aromas of blackberry and plum, with subtle hints of underbrush. The palate is juicy and succulent, immediately enveloping the senses and finishing with ultra-fine tannins. Flavours of ripe plum are complemented by delicate notes of star anise and warm spice. A truly trustworthy, go-to wine that delivers consistent quality and character

This versatile wine pairs wonderfully with classic pizzas like prosciutto or mushroom, slow-cooked beef bourguignon, grilled lamb chops, or herb-crusted yellowtail. For dessert, try poached pears in red wine.
