

Nederburg Baronne 2000

Now we can enjoy this modern wine style which brings together the outstanding features of the two noble varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. The colour is red with youthful garnet. The flavour is showing up-front fruit with strong berry Cabernet characteristics plus spice, cinnamon and elegant leathery Shiraz fingerprints. Well-rounded on the palate with firm wood imparted tannins and soft vanilla, the wine is well balanced with a long and pleasant finish. Enjoy Nederburg Baronne with roast of lamb, coq au vin, red meat steak, venison, mature cheese, pizza and pasta dishes.

in the vineyard : The Nederburg Baronne, a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz was first produced in 1973. Started as a lighter style blend among the Nederburg reds, the wine changed with time and the arrival of the new Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz clones, planted in selected cooler locations.

in the cellar : The wine was matured for 12 months in both 300 litre barrels and large oak vats.
