Sourced from our oldest vineyards, this Chenin Blanc offers a delicate yet deeply expressive profile. The nose reveals quince, pear, white nectarine, and hints of ginger, with a subtle citrus lift. The palate is bright and finely balanced, with well-integrated acidity adding precision. A touch of apple pith lingers on the finish, enhancing the wine's purity and length.

in the vineyard : This old-vine Chenin Blanc is a blend of our estate's oldest vineyards, planted in 1974 and 1976.

about the harvest: Grapes were hand-harvested.

in the cellar : Grapes were cooled overnight before undergoing spontaneous fermentation in 2500L foudre and 500L amphora. The wine was aged on the lees in these vessels for ten months, with the first SO2 addition made only after racking prior to bottling.
