

Perdeberg Lighthearted Lower in Alcohol Chenin Blanc 2025

Colour: Light straw

Bouquet: Lively and vibrant with tropical fruit aromas like white pear, guava and kiwifruit on the nose.

Taste: A refreshingly soft palate.

This wine pairs well with light summer dishes like vegetable & shrimp rice paper spring rolls or salmon tacos with avocado lime dressing.

Sometimes the simplest experiences can spark the most joy: dewdrops glittering in the rising sun, the honey-sweet scent of wildflowers, a butterfly in flight. It's the beauty in the everyday that touches the heart and makes the spirit light. Light on the body, too, is this lively Chenin Blanc. Brimming with zesty citrus and tropical fruit notes, it is low in alcohol yet full in flavour.

about the harvest: Vintage: The 2025 harvest was marked by slightly below-average volumes, a result of the dry conditions experienced during the late summer and harvest period. These weather conditions proved advantageous for grape quality, resulting in good natural acidity and sugar levels in the grapes. This balance of concentrated flavours, intense colour and vibrant acidity promises exceptional wines for the vintage.

Harvested from a 20-year-old bush vine vineyard in the Paarl region, the grapes were picked at 22°Balling to ensure the fresh style of the wine.

in the cellar : Method: Under dryland conditions, Chenin Blanc produces small berries with good flavour concentration. 30% of the wine was dealcoholised mid-fermentation to achieve a low alcohol level. No lees contact took place after fermentation.
