

Perdeberg Lighthearted Lower in Alcohol Pinotage 2024

Colour: Bright Red.

Bouquet: Red fruit, cherries and plum on the nose.

Taste: Flavours of red berries, cherry, and a hint of chocolate are on the palate, complemented by an elegant tannin structure. This wine has a great varietal expression and flavours with a touch of oak that helps with complexity, mouthfeel and colour stability.

This wine pairs well with red meat dishes, but can also be enjoyed with lighter meals like wild mushroom quinoa risotto or a vegetarian ramen noodle bowl.

Sometimes the simplest experiences can spark the most joy: dewdrops glittering in the rising sun, the honey-sweet scent of wildflowers, a butterfly in flight. It's the beauty in the everyday that touches the heart and makes the spirit light. Light on the body, too, is this lively Pinotage. Brimming with spicy plum and dark fruit notes, it is low in alcohol yet full in flavour.

about the harvest: The 2024 harvest started two weeks earlier than the previous year. However, unforeseen winds during late November and early December resulted in a reduced yield. Despite this, the anticipated quality remains exceptional. Elevated temperatures in early February necessitated an early grape harvest by the team.

Harvested from bush vine vineyards in the Paarl region, the grapes were picked at 25° Balling to ensure a soft and fruity style of wine.

in the cellar : Method: Pinotage produces small berries with good flavour concentration under dryland conditions. 30% of the wine was de-alcoholised mid-fermentation to achieve a low alcohol level.

Wood maturation: Six months with French oak staves.
