Ruby red. An abundance of ripe dark berry fruit and dark chocolate aromas with nuances of cassis. A medium-bodied wine with ripe dark fruit and delicate oak spice flavours, silky tannins and a lingering, youthful aftertaste. Excellent drinkability

in the vineyard : The grapes were sourced from vineyards across the Western Cape. The viticulturist works hand-in-hand with the grape growers in managing each vineyard block to ensure the best quality fruit for this wine. The different microclimates and soil types associated with each vineyard add to the complexity of the wine.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand and machine at 23° to 24.5° Balling from midFebruary until the end of March.

in the cellar : The fruit was crushed and then cool-fermented on the skins in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks at 25° to 28°C for two weeks. Upon completion of malolactic fermentation, the wine was matured in contact with French and American oak for a period of eight months.
