

Groot Phesantekraal Anna de Koning Reserve Chenin Blanc 2024

The 2024 Anna de Koning opens with vibrant and expressive aromas of unripe pineapple, white pear, honeysuckle, and a subtle hint of dried grass—an elegant nod to its cool-climate origins. On the palate, the wine strikes a seamless balance between richness and finesse, with a dense, layered texture lifted by a bright, mouthwatering acidity.

A distinct saline minerality runs through the wine, while the fruit remains pure and finely etched. The finish is long and lingering, echoing notes of citrus zest and wet stone.

in the vineyard : Crafted from a single block of Chenin Blanc planted in 2008 on decomposed Malmesbury Shale soils, this wine reflects its terroir. The vineyard's vertical shoot positioning and low yield of 8 tonnes per hectare contribute to the wine's concentration and balance. Handpicked grapes ensure optimal ripeness and integrity of fruit.

in the cellar : The juice was fermented and matured in a combination of 500L amphorae (7%), seasoned French oak barrels (57%), and a concrete egg (36%). This Chenin Blanc reveals remarkable complexity and textural finesse. Extended lees contact for seven months across all vessels has added depth and nuance without overshadowing the purity of the fruit.
