in the vineyard : Terroir: Deep Red soils. Hutton

Vineyard type: Trellised

Yield: 8-10t/ha

Balling: 25 - 28°B

in the cellar : Destemmed into open fermenters, punch down during fermentation. Once the desired sugar levels have been reached, the fermentation is stopped by adding alcohol to the fermenting must. The wine is aged in old barrels. Different vintages are used to do the blends.
