

Morgenhof Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2000

This wine has a deep dark inky red colour. This is a full bodied, complex wine with luscious fruit tannins, well integrated with the wood flavour. The nose shows flavours of violets, cassis, black cherries, spice with a touch of cigarbox. The aftertaste is reminiscent of brumbeberries.

This wine will go well with most red meat. Other suggestions include rich fish, chicken casseroles, pasta dishes and cheeses.

ageing : This wine will benefit by further bottle maturation in good cellar-facilities for 5 - 7 years and should reach its full potential by 2005.

in the vineyard : Produced, made and bottled on Morgenhof Wine Estate. This farm is 4km from Stellenbosch and 25km from Paarl on the R44 road. The vineyards age varies from 7-14 years and are planted on mainly West-North West and West South-West facing slopes.

in the cellar : The wine has spent 20 months in 40% first fill and 60% second and a small part of third fill barrels.
