Vinalies Internationales 2004 - Vinalies d'Or Gold

A fruity New World style Shiraz with cherry and plum flavours upfront with a hint of violet. The wood flavours are well integrated supported with some spice and pepperiness unique to this cultivar.

Roasts, venison, steak, etc. will be complimented well by this wine.
