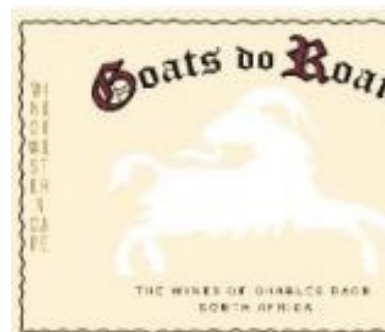


Fairview Goats do Roam Rosé 2002

ageing : The wine is super now. Enjoy over the next year or two.

in the vineyard : The grapes were harvested from vineyards in the Paarl, Piekensklouf, Pedeberg and Malmesbury regions. The grapes are mostly sourced from dry farmed old bush vines. These are mostly vineyards with small cropping levels resulting in wine with considerable concentration.

about the harvest: The different varietals were harvested ripe.

in the cellar : The different varietals were crushed. Juice being drawn off the red grapes and cold fermented at 14 degrees C.
