

Agusta Cabernet Sauvignon 2002

This wine shows true varietal character with lushes ripe fruit and an elegant palate. The wine has cassis, a hint of chocolate, cedar wood and attractive vanilla on the nose that follow through on the palate. The bottles have been sealed with a "twist top" as this is the worlds only closure that can guarantee quality, free from cork faults.

This wine is great with game; quail and duck are also a perfect match. Try some hard cheeses like Pecorino or Parmesan if you dare.
