

Agusta Merlot 2002

This concentrated wine shows true varietal character with lusher ripe fruit and a gripping palate. The wine has mulberry, dark chocolate, mocha and attractive vanilla on the nose, which follow through on the palate.

The bottles have been sealed with a "twist top" as this is the worlds only closure that can guarantee quality, free from cork faults.

This wine is great with beef and red wine sauce; venison with a juniper or chocolate sauce would be a match made in heaven.
