

## Laborie Sauvignon Blanc 2001

The wine has typical greenpepper and grassy flavours, as well as hints of tropical fruit. On the palate, it is pleasant and dry, with a lively acidity.

**variety :** Sauvignon Blanc | Sauvignon Blanc

**winery :** Laborie Wines

**winemaker :** Gideon Theron

**wine of origin :** Paarl

**analysis :** alc : 13.05 % vol   rs : 2.22 g/l   pH : 3.20   ta : 8.26 g/l

**ageing :** It has a maturation potential of two years.

**in the vineyard :** Climate: Wet winters and warm summers, tempered by cool ocean breezes from over the mountain.

Soil: Weathered granite and clovelly from Paarl Mountain.

**about the harvest:** Grapes were harvested at 22° Balling, after which 24 hours of skin contact was allowed.

**in the cellar :** They were fermented with selected yeast and left on the lees for a short period to give complexity and an earthy character.
