

Constantia Uitsig Semillon Reserve 2001

As the wine was aged and fermented in small French oak barrels for 12 months it has a robust toasty, buttery whiffs on the nose with a hint of citrus, developing into subtle honey on the palate and a lengthy almond aftertaste.
