The flagship of the Estate.

Rich warm plumy red with bright crimson rim, youthful with fruit aromas, fruitcake, some blackcurrant red cherries, complemented by a touch of chocolate, well structured wine with ripe tannins to match, woven deep into the texture of the wine. Harmonious blend of Cabernet Sauvignon 65% and Merlot 35%.

Rump steak, or kudu in fillet in red wine, or sirloin steak with tangy mustard sauce.

about the harvest: The grapes were picked at 24.5 - 25° Balling.

in the cellar: The grapes earmarked for this blend were treated with special care in the cellar. The Cabernet Sauvignon was on the skins for 28 days and the Merlot for 14-18 days. Matured for 18 months in small new Merlot oak 225 litre barrels.
