about the harvest: Vintage 2001 is characterised as a great summer with soft, dry conditions and excellent high quality fruit. Harvesting started the last week in January, 3 weeks after the completion of vendage vert, and continued for 10 days. Only domain fruit is utilised, from vineyards ranging in age from 4 to 10 years. It is the particular soil and microclimate of the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley in Hermanus, which has once again offered a vintage with its own particular characteristics.

in the cellar : 12 Barrels were selected, and only 300 cases produced.
