

Roberts Rock Cinsaut/Chenin Blanc 2002

This is an appealing light fruity wine. Scents reminiscent of strawberry and spice can be tasted. Lively acidity complements the fresh fruitiness of the wine.

Enjoy with cold meats, sausages, also fresh summer fruits, especially strawberries and cream.

in the vineyard : Climate: Mediterranean - $\hat{A}\pm$ 600 mm rain annually with moderate dry summer days, with a cool breeze from the Atlantic Ocean in the afternoons.

Soil: Table Mountain sandstone, Granite and Malmesbury shale. Sandy topsoil and clay subsoil.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested at optimum ripeness and fermented dry before this special blend was made.

in the cellar : After blending the wine was fined, stabilised and bottled.
