This is the first red from Danie de Wet. This wine shows soft plum and ripe berry fruit. It is an elegant wine, ideal with most red meat dishes and casseroles.

in the vineyard : The ideal soil conditions for vineyard cultivation in the Cape allows Danie de Wet to match specific cultivars to their ideal soil requirements, in the belief that good wine is made in the vineyard, not in the cellar.

Yield: 6 tons per hectare

Soil type: Gravel lime

Trellising style: 6 Wire fence system, cordon with spur pruning

in the cellar : The juice for this wine was cold soaked before it was fermented.

Malolactic fermentation took place in small French Oak barrels whereafter it matured in the barrels for several months before bottling.
