

Pinehurst Dry Red 2002

Soft, easy drinking wine with pronounced fruit flavours. Well balanced with soft tannins and ripe fruit. Serve with pork, chicken and casseroles.

about the harvest: The grapes for the Pinehurst Dry Red are handpicked.

in the cellar : Handpicked, crushed, destemmed into stainless steel fermenters. Soft pump overs 3 times/day until 6-7° Balling. Fermentation finished in tank after pressing of the skins.

Barrel details: 30% aged in barrels for 9 months. 70% aged in stainless steel tanks for 9 months.
