

Carl Everson Sauvignon Blanc Semillon 2002

This wine is a good combination of the grassy herbaceous tropical fruit characters of Sauvignon Blanc blended with the more complex stronger fruit concentration of Semillon. A strong acid complements this fruity strong wine.

about the harvest: The Sauvignon Blanc grapes were harvested early morning, and were crushed in a reductive style under a protective blanket of CO2. It was later blended with Semillon that was harvested at a riper Belling.
