

Carl Everson Sauvignon Blanc Semillon 2002

This wine is a good combination of the grassy herbatious tropical fruit characters of Sauvignon Blanc blended with the more complex stronger fruit concentration of Semillon. A strong acid complements this fruity strong wine.


