

Nederburg Paarl Riesling 2003

The 2003 Nederburg Paarl Riesling is a dry, crisp wine with a good fruity character that teams up well with a variety of dishes such as tuna, most seafoods and white meat roasts and those prepared with cream or cheese sauces.

in the vineyard : The grapes for this, one of South Africa's most popular dry white wines, were sourced from Cape Riesling (Cruchen Blanc) vineyards in the Paarl Valley, picked between 20th and 20.5th Balling.

in the cellar : Only free run juice was used and fermentation took place at 13th°C. The wine was made in reductively to preserve freshness and flavour, as this variety is particularly prone to oxidation.
